4. Write a few Scriptures about how God enables you to do what He called you to do, such as Philippians 4:13 and Psalms 1:3.

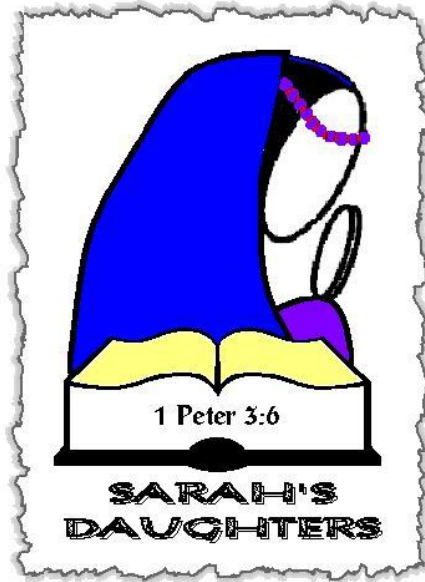
Chapter 15: "Now I Lay Me Down to Sleep"
